The academic year is divided into two semesters: winter and spring.
<b>Courses</b> of the winter term start on the last week of September and finish on the second week of December; those of the spring term start on the third week of February and finish by 31/May.
<b>Exams</b> of the winter term are in January and in early February, while those of the spring term take place between 01/June and 25/July and during the September session.
Each Department publishes its own calendar at the beginning of the academic year.
